Back in September 2023, the Kaleidoscope Academy launched its new Behaviour Curriculum across all the schools. We are delighted to say that the curriculum has been implemented successfully and is now becoming a part of the normal expectations in school.

Alongside a school's behaviour curriculum, runs a behaviour rewards and consequences program to ensure that positive behaviour expectations are celebrated and that negative behaviour choices are noticed and addressed to support the pupil in making better choices in the future.

The Kaleidoscope Behaviour Team have been researching and working on a new outline of consequences that will be launched, very soon, in every school with the aim of building a structure similar to what's in place in each school to support all pupils and maintain high expectations. Each class will have a brand new consequence chart so that all pupils can access it if the need to.

Each school will keep their own individual reward systems in place as pupils come to expect certain rewards and we don't want them to be disappointed.

The new consequences chart and rationale will be shared with parents in a presentation arranged by your school to explain and go through them. Each school will present these to their pupils.
